

Project Background

- Retail Assessment completed in 2016
- Calculated a primary trade area of 134,031 people
- Identified future retail nodes, including the property under contract
- Identified tenants with no presence in the trade area – including Costco





Retail Leakage

The 2017 assessment identified over 1,000,000 SF in retail "leakage" or unmet demand in our trade area

- Ranked #15 on the Fortune 500 rankings




Project Overview

- Site under contract at NW corner of Lakeway
 Drive & Interstate 35
- Planned Unit Development
- Construction of a 150,000 SF Costco retail store within five years
- Development includes two public roads and creation of multiple out-lots
- \$20,000,000 capital investment

Costco Incentive Package Proposal

Incentive	Amount
Sales Tax Reimbursement	\$2,000,000
GTEC Infrastructure Reimbursement	\$2,000,000
GEDCO Natural Gas Extension	\$400,000
TOTAL INCENTIVE AMOUNT	\$4,400,000



Costco Incentive Package Proposal

- Incentive package has a 2.9 year payback period to the City of Georgetown
- Costco will be one of the largest sales tax producers for the City of Georgetown
- 10-year net benefit to Georgetown is approximately
 \$11,047,307



Item ??: Sales Tax Incentive

- Half-cent sales tax rebate (50% of the revenue to the general fund)
- Maximum of \$2,000,000 or 10 years, whichever occurs first
- Requirements:
 - Minimum capital investment of \$20,000,000 including facility and public improvements
 - Construction of improvements in accordance with the building standards and materials outlined in the PUD document
 - Completion of construction within five years

Item ??: GTEC Incentive

- \$2,000,000 infrastructure reimbursement grant to offset actual costs for design and construction of public roads
- Requirements:
 - Minimum capital investment of \$20,000,000 including facility and public improvements
 - Construction of improvements in accordance with city design and engineering standards
 - Completion of construction within five years
 - Five year claw back period



Item ??: GEDCO Incentive

- GEDCO will enter into a service line agreement with Atmos Energy to extend natural gas service to the Costco site
- If Costco triggers the expansion of the line, but does not complete construction, they will repay the expended amount of \$400,000
- Requirements:
 - Minimum capital investment of \$20,000,000 including facility and public improvements
 - Completion of construction within five years

Item ??: GEDCO Atmos Agreement

- GEDCO seeks to enter into a service line agreement with Atmos Energy to extend natural gas service to the Costco area
- Due to the development interest in this area, the extension can be triggered with any GEDCO approved project
- Five-year expiration
- GEDCO will pay \$400,000 and Atmos will pay for the remainder of the project (estimated at \$1,300,000 total)

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
