First Reading of an Ordinance regarding the Georgetown Village Public Improvement District

Purpose

- Staff has determined the need to update Section 2.115.030 of the Code of Ordinances regarding members and terms of the Georgetown Village Public Improvement District No. 1 Advisory Board.
- Currently, it consists of seven members and two alternates. Five of the members are resident homeowners of Georgetown Village and two are representatives of the developer.
- Per Section 2.115.030.A.2, the two Development Members are to resign and be replaced by two resident homeowners "at such time as the development of the Georgetown Village PUD Concept Plan is complete."
- In the coming weeks, the development of the Georgetown Village PUD Concept Plan will be complete, and the Development Members shall resign and be replaced by two GV Members.
- In addition, the desire is to remove the alternate positions, which are currently unoccupied and have never been needed to attain a quorum.
