AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GEORGETOWN, TEXAS ("CITY") REPEALING ARTICLE III OF CHAPTER 14.28 OF THE GEORGETOWN CODE OF ORDINANCES; REPEALING CONFLICTING ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS; MAKING SUCH OTHER FINDINGS AND PROVISIONS RELATED TO THE SUBJECT; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, since October 1, 2017 American Medical Response of Texas, Inc., dba American Medical Response, ("Franchisee") has held a non-exclusive right, privilege, and franchise to operate a medical transfer service on the public rights-of-way of the City; and

WHEREAS, Franchisee's franchise shall expire on September 30, 2022 and Franchisee did not request a three-year extension of the franchise by submitting an application to the City's Fire Chief no later than six months prior to the expiration of the franchise; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it necessary to repeal Article III of Chapter 14.28 of the Code of Ordinances.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GEORGETOWN, TEXAS THAT:

Section 1. The facts and recitations contained in the preamble of this ordinance are hereby found and declared to be true and correct and are incorporated by reference herein and expressly made a part hereof, as if copied verbatim.

Section 2. Article III of Chapter 14.28 of the City's Code of Ordinances is hereby repealed.

Section 3. All ordinances or resolutions that are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are, and the same are hereby, repealed and all other ordinances or resolutions of the City not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. If any provision of this ordinance, or application thereof, to any person or circumstance, shall be held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions, or application thereof, of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

Section 5. The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign this ordinance and the City Secretary to attest. This ordinance shall become effective and be in full force and effect on October 1, 2022.
