**A RESOLUTION CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE
RESULTS OF THE CITY OF GEORGETOWN GENERAL ELECTION HELD
ON MAY 4, 2019**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Georgetown, Texas ordered a general election to be held on Saturday, May 4, 2019, for the purpose of electing Councilmembers for Districts 3, 4 and 7;

WHEREAS, on May 4th, an election was held on the following:

To elect a Councilmember from the City of Georgetown Single-member District 3; to elect a Councilmember from the City of Georgetown Single-member District 4; and to elect a Councilmember from the City of Georgetown Single-Member District 7; and

WHEREAS, the election officers who held said election have prepared the returns of the results thereof, and the returns have been delivered to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, it appears from the returns, duly and legally made, that the following votes were cast:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GEORGETOWN TEXAS, that:

SECTION I.

The City Council officially finds and determines that the election was duly called; that proper notice of the election was given in accordance with law; that the election was held in accordance with law; that returns of the results of the election have been made and delivered, and that the City Council has canvassed the returns, all in accordance with the law and the resolution calling the election.

SECTION II.

It appears from said returns, duly and legally made, that Mike Triggs was duly elected as the Councilmember for the City of Georgetown Single-Member District 3, and that Steve Fought was duly elected as the Councilmember for the City of Georgetown Single-Member District 4, and that Tommy Gonzalez was duly elected as the Councilmember for the City of Georgetown, Single Member District 7.
