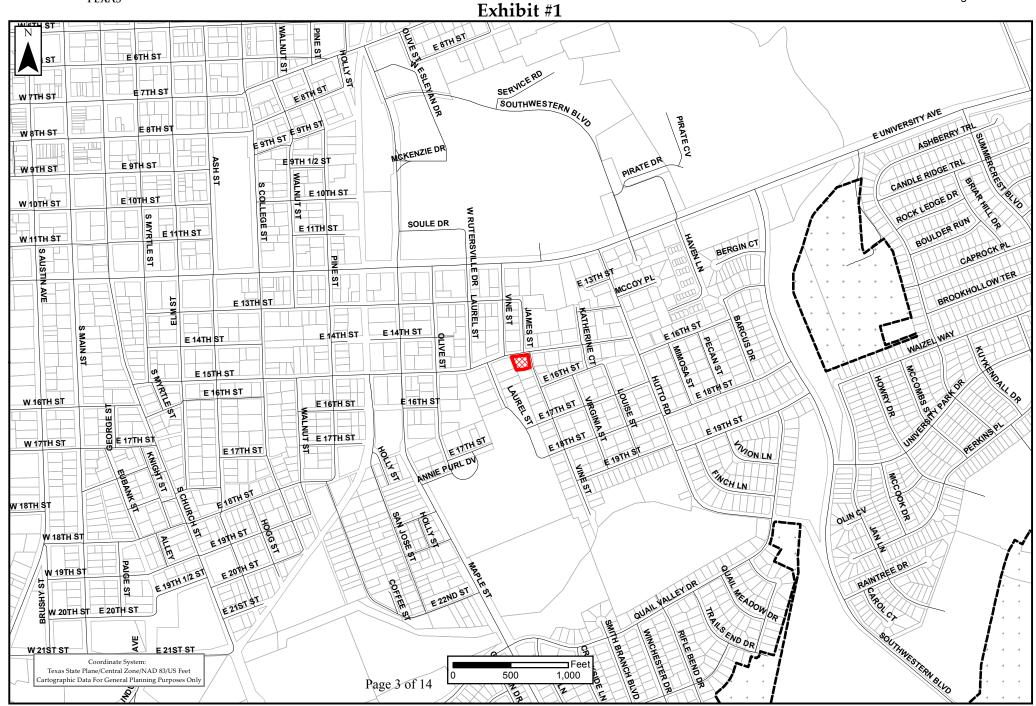

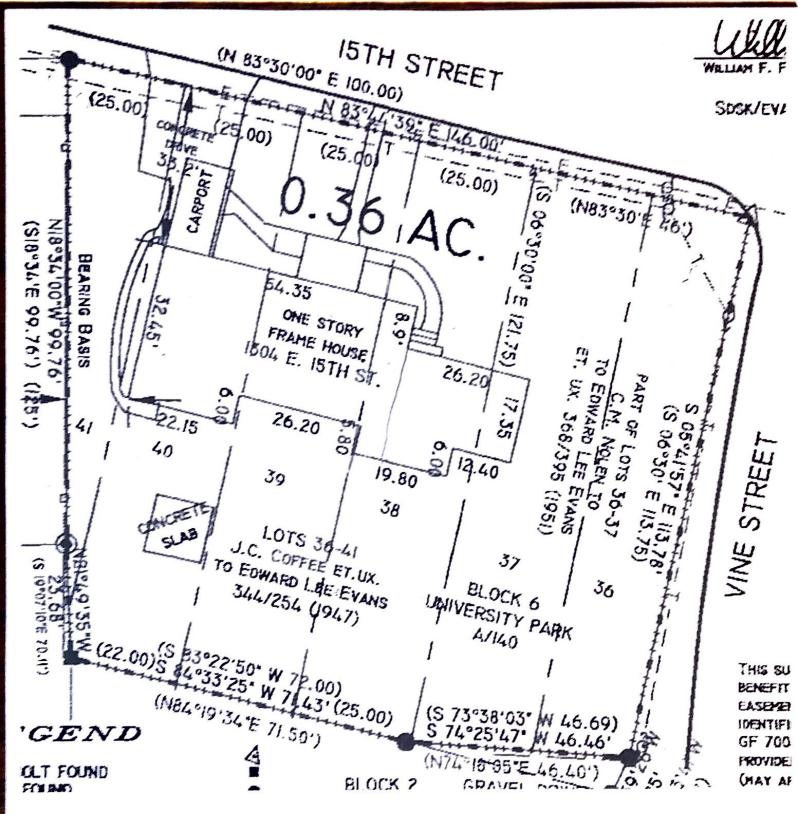

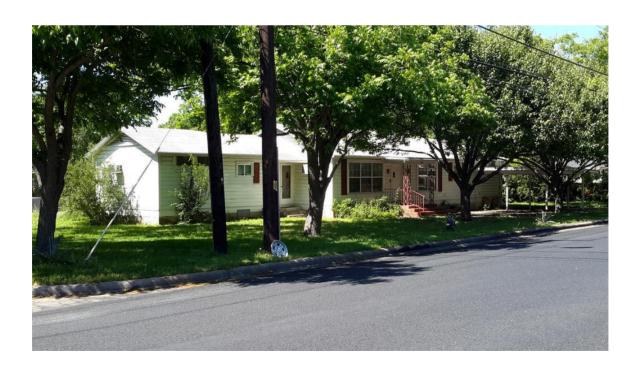
1304 East 15<sup>th</sup> Front Side
